Women's Outreach Center

1. The Women's Outreach Center (WOC) was first founded on the University of Oklahoma's campus in 1999 after a women's interest needs assessment was held, suggesting an organization that provided resources and information for women and the LGBTQ community.
2. The Women's Outreach Center provides trainings and presentations to seven programs they host. (One Sooner, Step In Speak Out, Sooner Ally, Greek Ally, Sexperts, D8ME, OU Advocates)
3. 90 percent of transgender workers report some form of harassment or mistreatment on the job. (LGBTQ, Sooner Ally and Greek Ally all work with the inequality of sexual orientation.)
4. Eight out of 10 women wear the wrong size bra. (Boob-a-Palooza, Shape It Up and the annual Pink and Black Ball are all events hosted by the WC to promote and inform about breast health.
5. One in five women are sexually assaulted while in college and most often in their freshmen or sophomore year. (Step In Speak Out is a program hosted by the WOC that informs students about sexual assault and encourages them to be active bystanders on campus)
6. The WOC's staff includes Director Kathy Moxley, Assistant Director Melanie Adams, and Program Coordinator Kasey Catlett.
7. The WOC provides resources for 11 different subjects: Breast Health, Child Care, Dating and Domestic Violence, Eating Disorders, LGBTQ, Sexual Assault, Sexual Health, Single Parent, Stalking, Voting and Working Women.
8. National Women's Equality Day is Aug. 26. The WOC holds an individual tabling and partners with SGA and their campaign, OU Votes to recruit new voters every year.
9. Women still earn only .77 cents to every dollar a man earns. The WOC hosts the \$tart \$mart workshop, which provides women with information on how to overcome the gender wage gap with negotiation skills.

10. The Women's Outreach Center is located in Room 247 in the Oklahoma Memorial Union, down the hall from Meachum Auditorium.
11. The official color for Domestic Violence is purple.
12. The number for OU Advocates is 405-615-0013. Previously called the Sexual Assault Response Team, OU Advocates is a 24/7 hotline that provides assistance, support and resources to the caller, at any time of day.
13. The University of Oklahoma will not issue an alcohol violation if a sexual assault occurs and alcohol or a minor is involved. The university prioritizes safety and protection above all.
14. The WOC is home to 10 student interns and three faculty members.

16. Hours of Operation for the WOC are M-F 8am-5pm, where it is open to walk-ins for resources, consultations or even free condoms!
